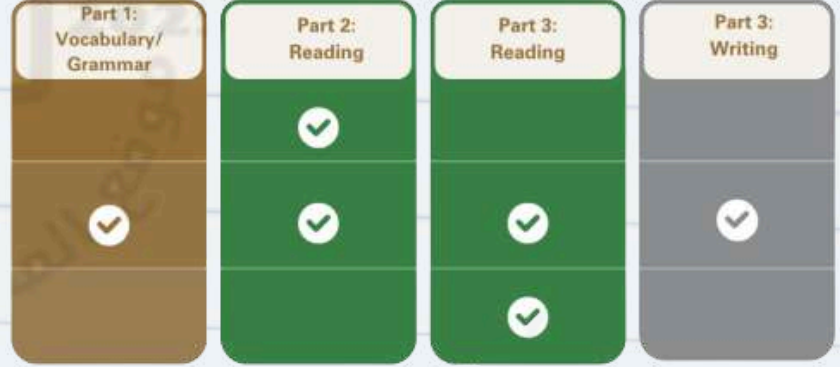


Structure

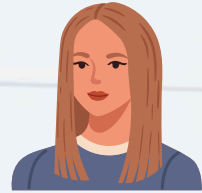

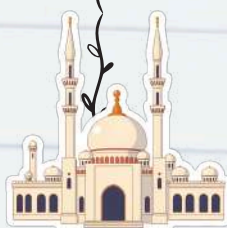

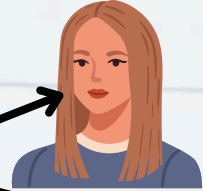
